

FARNBOROUGH TOWN CENTRE SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT

As part of the Rushmoor Plan (the Local Development Framework) Rushmoor Borough Council has produced a Supplementary Planning Document relating to Farnborough town centre.

A report went to the Rushmoor Council' Cabinet meeting of 19 June 2007 and the Cabinet resolved that, "subject to further discussions with the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds on Special Protection Area related issues, approval be given to the adoption of the revised Farnborough Town Centre Supplementary Planning Document."

Those discussions took place and Rushmoor Council wrote to RSPB on 15 June with respect to these discussions. Various changes have been made to the Habitats Regulation (Appropriate) Assessment Report associated with the SPD.

The SPD is to be adopted by Rushmoor Borough Council on 17 July 2007.

Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD.

Any such application must be made promptly and, in any event, not later than 17 October 2007.
